Introduction

This is a template for the COGAIN Conference papers. It provides an example of how a COGAIN 2009 paper should be formatted. An example of a figure is given (see Figure 1) as well as an example of a reference (Doe et al., 2006). The list of references should be ordered alphabetically. When citing a reference in the text, if the paper has three authors or more, give only the name of the first author followed by et al., i.e. a paper with one author should be cited as (Doe, 2006), a paper with two authors as (Doe & Smith, 2006), and a paper with three authors or more as (Doe et al., 2006). The template follows the format used in the previous COGAIN Proceedings, available online at http://www.cogain.org/cogain2009/COGAIN2009_Proceedings.pdf.

COGAIN 2009 is the fifth annual conference of COGAIN ‘COmmunication by GAze INteraction’, a European Union funded research Network of Excellence.

Submission of Papers

Authors are requested to submit their short papers using the COGAIN conference format (this template, available at <http://www.cogain.org/cogain2009>). The submitted short papers will be blind reviewed. A condition of acceptance is that at least one of the authors will attend the conference. As a guide a short paper should be taken to mean two - three pages of text (c. 1000 - 1500 words), plus supporting images/diagrams/tables. The text should be clear enough to allow reviewers to judge the potential of the papers suitability for COGAIN 2009. The official language of the conference will be English. The suitability of the paper will be judged by the reviewers on the following criteria:

- Originality
- Statements of main results obtained so far (need not be final results)
- Clear identification of future research needs
- Clarity of presentation
- Technical soundness

The short paper should include in addition a separate cover page with:¹ Title; All authors names (underline surname), affiliations, and addresses; Name of author to contact for correspondence; Email

¹For blind review, please omit the authors' details from the paper itself but submit them separately when submitting the paper for review.

address and fax number of contact; Up to 5 keywords to describe the paper; Requirements for video presentation equipment.
